## Materials You'll Need

- Size 10 crochet thread (approximately 200 yards)
- Size 8 crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

## Understanding Filet Crochet

Filet crochet is a unique crochet technique that uses a series of double crochet (dc) and chain (ch) stitches to create openwork designs. In this pattern, we will create a grid of dc and ch stitches, and then fill in specific squares to form the bluebird motifs.

### Step-by-Step Instructions

1. **Create the Base:** Start by chaining 66. Single crochet (sc) in the second chain from the hook and in each chain across. (65 sc)
2. **Row 1:** Chain 3 (counts as dc). dc in the next ch-sp, \*ch 1, skip the next ch-sp, dc in the next ch-sp. Repeat from \* across. (33 dc)
3. **Row 2:** Chain 3, dc in the same st, \*ch 1, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (33 dc)
4. **Row 3:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (22 dc)
5. **Row 4:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, dc in the next dc, ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (16 dc)
6. **Row 5:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next 2 dc, ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (13 dc)
7. **Row 6:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next 3 dc, ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (10 dc)
8. **Row 7:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next 4 dc, ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (9

dc)

9. **Row 8:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next 5 dc, ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (8 dc)
10. **Row 9:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next 6 dc, ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (8 dc)
11. **Row 10:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next 7 dc, ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (8 dc)
12. **Row 11:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next 8 dc, ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (9 dc)
13. **Row 12:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next 9 dc, ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (10 dc)
14. **Row 13:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next 10 dc, ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (11 dc)
15. **Row 14:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next 11 dc, ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (12 dc)
16. **Row 15:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next 12 dc, ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (13 dc)

17. **Row 16:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next 13 dc, ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (14 dc)
18. **Row 17:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next 14 dc, ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (15 dc)
19. **Row 18:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next 15 dc, ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (16 dc)
20. **Row 19:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next 16 dc, ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (17 dc)
21. **Row 20:** Chain 3, dc in the next st, \*ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next 17 dc, ch 1, skip the next dc, dc in the next dc. Repeat from \* across. (18 dc)

## **Creating the Bluebird Motifs**

Once you have created the base, it's time to fill in the squares to form the bluebird motifs. Refer to the diagram below for the placement of the blue squares.

To fill in a square, simply work a double crochet (dc) stitch into the corresponding chain-space or double crochet stitch.

## **Finishing Touches**

Once you have completed the filet crochet, it's time to add the finishing touches. Weave in any loose ends and block the scarf end to give it a crisp

and polished look.

## Additional Tips

- Use a light-colored thread to make it easier to see your stitches.
- Take your time and count your stitches carefully to avoid mistakes.
- If you make a mistake, don't panic. Simply undo the incorrect stitches and try again.
- Have fun and enjoy the creative process!

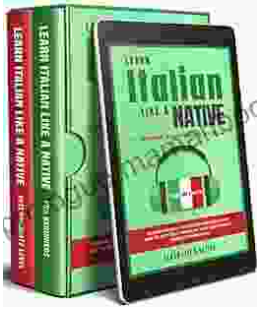

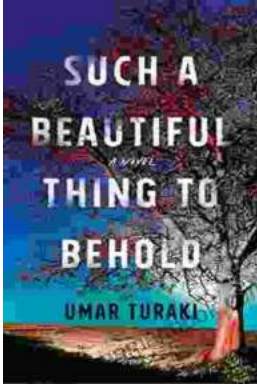
